FREE TRIP TO SEE THE NATIONAL WWII MEMORIAL IN WASHINGTON D.C.

Kilroy's Krew is a volunteer organization whose mission is to recognize and honor our WWII Veterans for their sacrifices and achievements. We are recognizing them by taking as many as possible on a trip to Washington, DC to see the National World War II Memorial that was built in their honor, and we will also visit numerous other Memorials as time permits.

### This is at **NO COST TO THE VETERAN**.

Every Veteran will have an escort with them at all times. A family member (other than a spouse) is encouraged to be their escort. If a family member is unable to accompany them, an escort will be provided for them. The escort's minimum tax deductible donation is \$500 to cover their own costs (larger donations are appreciated). (NO CHARGE TO THE VETERAN)

The Veterans are cared for with tender loving care at all times.

There is a photographer that documents every piece of the trip to provide a forever memory for the Veteran and their escort/family member.

Wheelchairs are provided for every Veteran, so mobility is safe and productive.
